Built in 1891, the historic Darlington Schoolhouse is located in New Jersey's Highlands Preservation Area, adjacent to 100,000 acres of parks and open space in New Jersey and New York.

The new headquarters serves the Trail Conference's mission of Connecting People with Nature. It is not only a center for trail volunteer training, land conservation planning, and trail-focused publishing, it is a meeting place for our region's outdoor recreation community.
